



Addendum for RFP_LANDS-01 and RFP_LANDS-02

Additional information as a result of questions received and general discussion.

1. RFP_LANDS-02 has been amended, page 5, Scope of the Project, point 2 last sentence should read; Approximate number of trees to be removed is 300.
2. Please be aware that there is limited to no cellular or internet capabilities in either of these project areas.
3. The contractor will be responsible for any necessary snow removal to facilitate the project.
4. SVCA will not provide a location for the dumping of chips or any other materials.
5. The project must be completed prior to April 2024.
6. The campers will be asked to remove all decorative items from campsites and may be in the work area, as well as the removal of all items attached to trees. The contractor will not be held responsible for any reasonable damage.
7. Contractors should assume that all trailers, decks, sheds, and other large fixtures will not be moved to facilitate the project.
8. Contractors will be permitted to stay on site during the project but must be mindful that there will not be any services available as the campgrounds will be closed and winterized.
9. The removal of unmarked trees that would be necessary for a person acting professionally to provide felling/access or other may be permitted on a case-by-case basis.
10. Contractors are permitted to inform potential buyers of materials generated through this project or the materials origin.
11. RFP_LANDS-01, the northeastern section of the project (horse camping/ Campbell) has a few trees along the ravine. These trees could be felled into the ravine and material left in ravine provided that the top is cut down.
12. RFP_LANDS-02, the most northwesterly portion (behind campsite #1) has 3 marked trees that could be felled and material left in the natural area provided that the top is cut down.
13. SVCA will not be providing any payment prior to the completion of each project individually.
