

Access points 1 and 2 are not shown on our map. These are not recommended due to possibility of high water, obstacles and heavy rapids.





Located at Maple Hill Dam. There is a portage a short ride down the river. Great parking but no amenities. <u>Map</u>



Located on popular Concession 8, 10 minutes from Walkerton. Great place to launch if you have a big group. There are 2 parking lots. <u>Map</u>



Exciting trek. Many amenities (playground, washrooms, picnic shelters, band shell and skateboard park). <u>Map</u>



Located at Lobie's Park in Walkerton. There's camping, playground, lots of parking and washrooms. <u>Map</u>



Located on a dirt road under a new bridge. Nice place to stop and stretch your legs and a calm place to launch. <u>Map</u>



Popular spot in summer. 2 places to launch on either side of the old bridge. Not many amenities but lots of friendly paddlers. <u>Map</u>



Located just outside Paisley. This is a popular entry point. Lots of parking available to leave your car. <u>Map</u>



Located just under Bruce Rd 40 bridge. Perfect spot to launch. Large parking lot leaves room to leave cars or drop your canoe off. <u>Map</u>



9a-just off main street of Paisley. 9b-right in downtown Paisley. Both have docks for an easy launch. Parking only on roadside. Can't leave cars there. <u>Map</u>





Located in Saugeen Bluffs CA. There are campsites along the river, washrooms and a camp store. <u>Map</u>



One of the most popular places to launch. Good place to park at the start or end of your trip. $\underline{\text{Map}}$



Located at old Sherk Bridge. There's plenty of parking and is a popular place to fish. <u>Map</u>



The last access point on the Saugeen River is located in Southampton. There's a large amount of parking and washroom facilities. <u>Map</u> Located at Denny's Dam. Great place to launch or end your trip. Plenty of parking and washroom facilities. <u>Map</u>

Portages along the Saugeen River:

Maple Hill Dam Hydro Dam Walkerton Dam

Denny's Dam

Portage on left (south bank), right upstream of the bridge.
The dam is 50 m downstream of the bridge.
Portage is 30 m above the dam on the left (west bank).
Portage sign posted on far left (west bank).
Dock and steps located on left (south bank) on the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry (MNRF) side.

The Saugeen River has a variety of water conditions depending on the weather and precipitation. There are wide areas of calm sections, mixed with mild rapids and eddies. The route is ideal for learning the basics of navigating rapid water. The route starts at Hanover Park and flows 102 km through scenic countryside, before emptying into Lake Huron in Southampton.
